







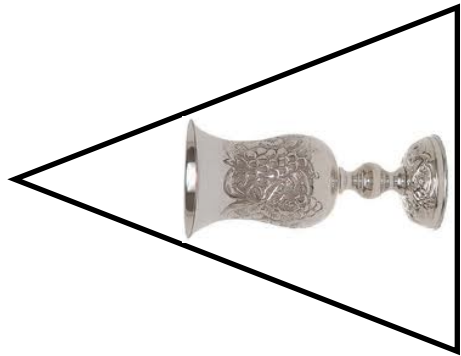
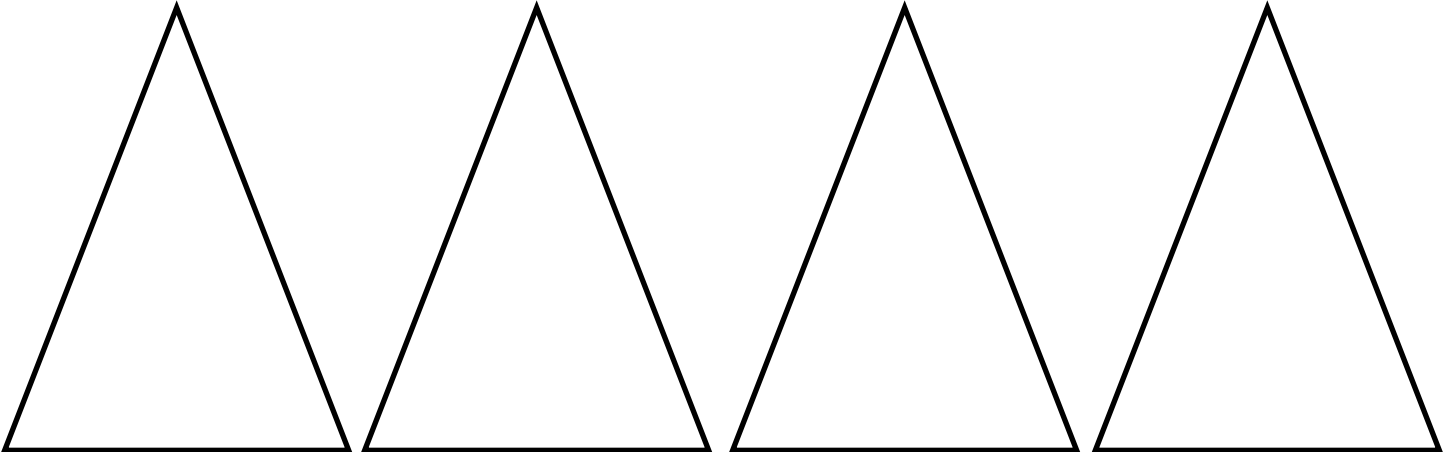
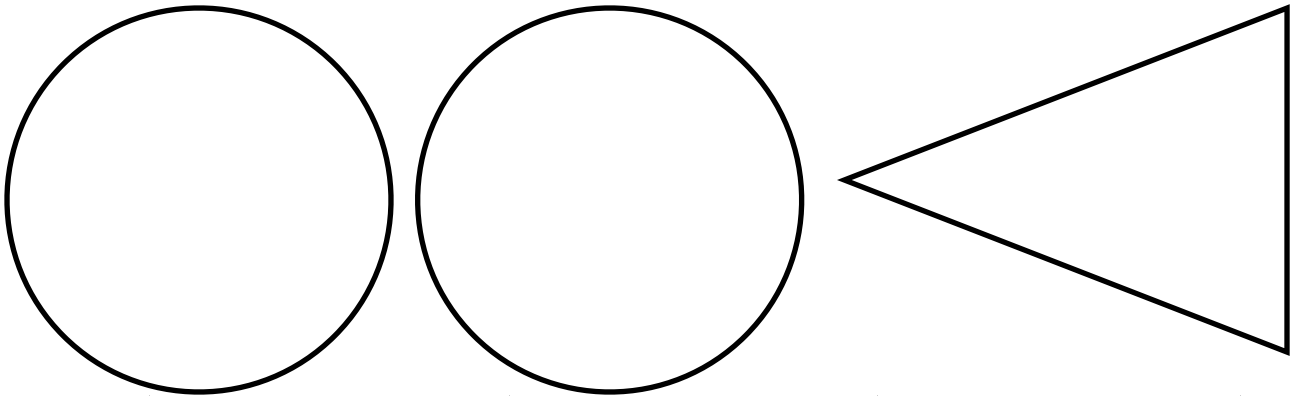
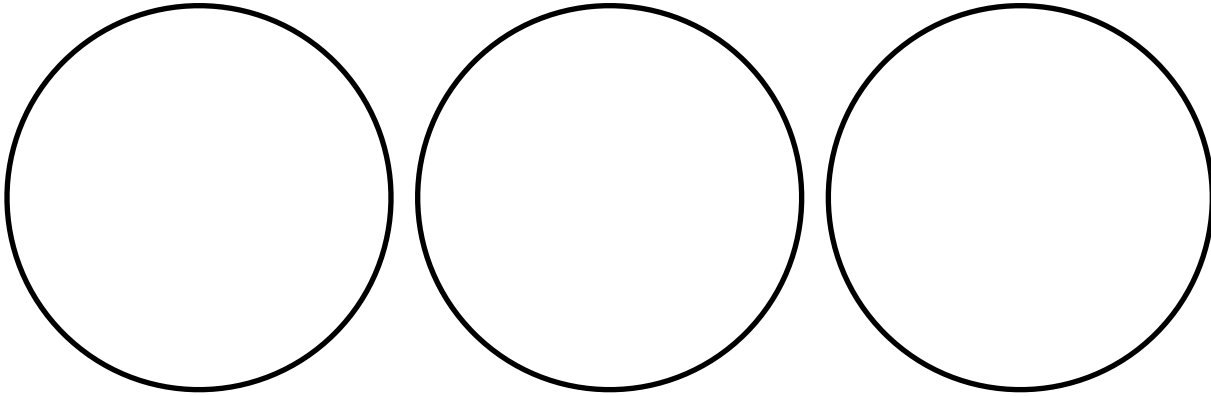
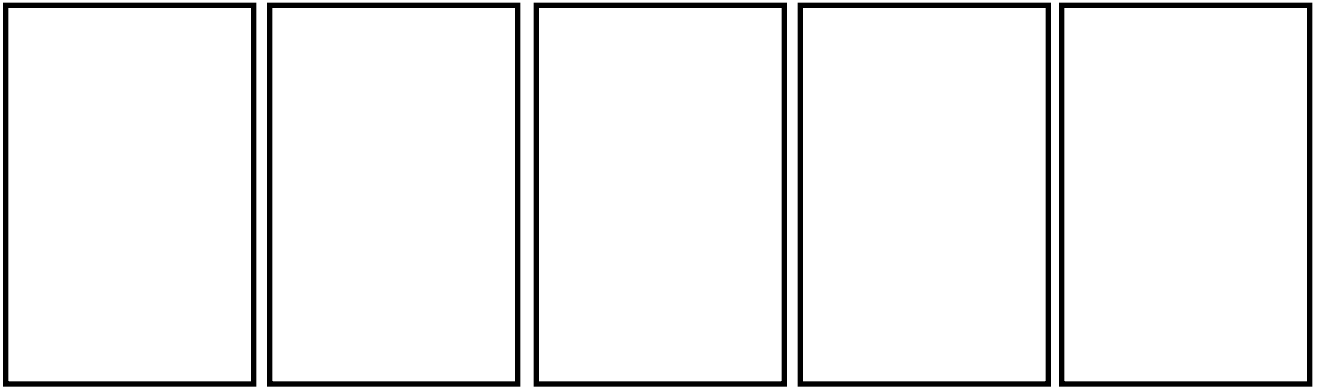


## Make Your Own Shabbat Grouping File Folder Activity

	<b>Print</b> pages three, four, and five of this document onto paper. Print page two, the page with the Shabbat objects, onto cardstock.
	<b>Laminate</b> the Shabbat pictures printed on cardstock.
	<b>Cut</b> out the shapes and characters printed on paper.
	<b>Glue</b> the paper shapes and characters onto a file folder.
	<b>Laminate</b> the entire file folder, if desired.
	<b>Cut</b> out the cardstock Shabbat objects.
	Apply <b>velcro</b> to the file folder and the backs of the cardstock Shabbat objects.
	<b>Tape</b> a sandwich bag on the opposite side of the file folder to store the pieces
